FROM THE DIRECTOR

Summer was a very busy and fruitful season for Ross Point, beginning with the 12th annual International Veterinary Leadership Experience and continuing through a silent retreat for Immaculate Conception of Post Falls. Along the way, we hosted numerous family reunions, school and university groups, camps for individual churches and other denomination, along with Ross Point sponsored events: Senior High - 57, Junior High - 110, Junior - 44, Middler - 38, My First Camp 19, Family Camp Omega - 155, and Camp Journey for children touched by cancer - 193.

More than a dozen campers accepted Christ's invitation for salvation this summer, claiming His Lordship in their lives. 11 individuals were baptised in the Spokane River publically confessing their faith in Jesus.

All of our sponsored camps are subsidized in one way or another. One of the primary ways is through operating income from guest groups the rest of the year. The Board of Directors is committed to using the income from guest groups to assist campers coming to our sponsored camps, as a vital function of the ministry of Ross Point.

The addition of Adam's Place, Ponderosa, and the meeting rooms, have increased our ability to effectively host returning and new groups. Being able to pay off the phase one loan and move to phase two, the addition of additional motel rooms, and phase three, the expansion of the Dining Room will further the vibrant mission and ministry of Ross Point.

I hope that you will continue to partner with Ross Point. I hope you will consider supporting Ross Point as we continue to expand God's work in this place. I hope to see you at camp in the coming year. I hope that you will have a special Christmas season, celebrating the grace and goodness of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ

We would like to invite your church family to attend the youth camps and/or family camp at Ross Point!

Summer Camp provides a unique and adventurous opportunity for initial Christian growth in an outdoor setting quite apart from the daily routine of home, school, work or other activities.
