

FROM THE DIRECTOR'S DESK

The theme for this summer is 'Secrets of the Kingdom' and preparations are underway for our youth and family camps. Recently a dear friend was sharing her excitement about the summer season and the invaluable opportunity it provides to present a Biblical World view in a day when so many people are not even familiar with scripture and the good news of the gospel of Jesus Christ. In many ways, our country can be compared to Hebrews in the time of the Judges when so many people just did whatever they wanted, instead of what God wanted. Even Jesus saw the harm in this and prayed that God's will would be done over His as He approached the cross for our salvation. Scripture calls us to be holy, as God is holy and to live our lives so that we grow closer to emulating Christ constantly. Certainly we will not attain that goal this side of heaven, but that does not mean we should be less vigilant in our striving toward that goal. She shared a wonderful portion of scripture that can serve as a guide for us: **Colossians 3:1-8** "Since, then, you have been raised with Christ, set your hearts on things above, where Christ is seated at the right hand of God. Set your minds on things above, not on earthly things. For you died, and your life is now hidden with Christ in God. When Christ, who is your life, appears, then you also will appear with him in glory. Put to death, therefore, whatever belongs to your earthly nature: sexual immorality, impurity, lust, evil desires, and greed, which is idolatry. Because of these, the wrath of God is coming. You used to walk in these ways, in the life you once lived. But now you must rid yourselves of all such things as these: anger, rage, malice, slander, and filthy language from your lips (NIV)." Scripture also challenges us to live lives that will not be a stumbling block to others, not letting our freedom cause them to stumble. She shared too the awesome responsibility we have to teach and share our faith at camp along with the warning of James that *Not many of you should become teachers, my fellow believers, because you know that we who teach will be **judged more** strictly.* A verse from Psalm 69 serves as a constant reminder to me: "Lord, the LORD Almighty, may those who hope in you not be disgraced because of me; God of Israel, may those who seek you not be put to shame because of me."

This summer many people will be choosing to serve God through Ross Point as full time staff, part time staff, volunteer counselors and directors, nurses, operations and maintenance. Others will choose to serve through donations for programs and scholarships which are increasingly needed. Still others will choose to regularly pray for the ministry of God at Ross Point. Perhaps you will respond to the call of God to serve Him at Ross Point this summer. For each of these people, I am grateful.

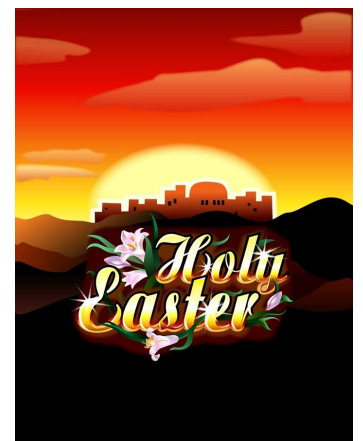
Please call the office if you would like to join us for breakfast. The price for breakfast is: \$6.00 for 12 and older, \$4.00 for 5—11 and
